3.4.1: Outcomes of Extension activities in the neighborhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years.

Bhaskar Pharmacy College contributed to a wide variety of public issues, which are subsequently addressed through the involvement of the community and technical professionals. The NSS section of the college is effectively carrying out a broad variety of service-oriented programs. There were a number of different efforts that the National Service Scheme (NSS) successfully organized, including an Anti-ragging awareness campaign, Active support for the Swatch Bharat program, Yoga Awareness Program and effective coordination of Blood donation campaigns. All of these activities were carried out within the allotted time period. The NSS unit is responsible for organizing a wide range of guest lectures on topics such as the protection of women, female entrepreneurs, and other types of general issues. The objective of the Annual Celebration of Yoga Day is to bring attention to the positive effects that yoga has on both the physical and mental well-being of individuals. A "Health care center" was established by BPC with the intention of promoting nutrition diet that is well-balanced and overall well-beingness. Guests staying at the hostel have access to a health club that features a variety of fitness facilities and medical services.

Students are encouraged to participate in community outreach projects via extension activities while they are enrolled at the institution. By going to the schools, orphanages and low-income neighborhoods in the surrounding area, teachers and students are able to interact with the local community that is disadvantaged and provide assistance to them. To encourage compassion and preventative medical care, the organization conducts a variety of events including blood donation drives, medical camps, social awareness campaigns and other additional activities. The organization conducts social awareness events with the purpose of teaching youngsters living on the streets and elderly people who are unable to provide for themselves how to create revenue and provide them with the opportunity to integrate into orphanages and senior homes. As part of their commitment to incorporate social responsibility, students participate in volunteer work in
